The UPA's actions at a glance

The UPA is the official voice when it comes to representing your interests to political, governmental, regional, and municipal leaders, as well as agri-food sector stakeholders and others. We speak on behalf of all of agriculture.

The money paid by producers is redistributed among the organization's different bodies (i.e., local syndicates, regional federations, and the Confederation) according to needs reflected in the current financial plan, which is approved by delegates at the annual UPA General Congress.
