When producers receive their notice of dues, they will also be able to request an alternative calculation for the assessment increase in lieu of a fixed tier. To do so, they must provide official proof of their business income. In this case, the increase will be calculated at \$0.95 per \$1,000 increment of gross farm income not covered by joint plans. (Subject to the approval of the Régie des marchés agricoles et alimentaires du Québec)
